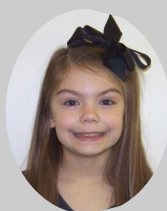
Who was Lottie Moon?

She is the namesake of the International Missions Offering. She was a hard-working, deep-loving Southern Baptist who labored tirelessly so her people group could know Jesus. Throughout her life, Lottie Moon urged Southern Baptists to support the work of missions, and send more missionaries to China. She died of starvation on a Japanese ship, December 24, 1912, because she gave away her salary to people in China she was trying to help. She was 72 years old.

Over 6,000 people groups, 1.7 billion people still live with no access to the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
